PHILOSOPHY

Plan of Care

An assessment is conducted to determine the client's care needs.

Family members, friends and other service providers are consulted in this process.

Recommendations are provided that address the behavioural, psycho-social, emotional and physical needs of clients. ■

Consultation and Co-ordination of Care

Consultation Services provide information that allows the senior and their family to make informed decisions regarding their specific care needs.

We arrange, co-ordinate and supervise direct services provided by Bartimaeus staff.

Upon request, we co-ordinate other services currently being provided by public or private organizations.

We act as a liaison to families, making sure things are going well and alerting families to any issues or problems.

We also co-ordinate relocation to or from a retirement home or a long-term care facility. ■

Direct Services

Behaviour associated with aging can often be difficult to manage for the senior, the caregiver and family. The three components of our Direct Services are:

1. ASSISTING THE SENIOR

Developing strategies to make everyday living more manageable and productive.

2. RESPITE CARE

In-home support provided to the caregiver, so that they may attend to their own needs. The service is flexible and designed to meet the unique needs of each caregiver.

3. SUPPORT SERVICES

Assistance with transportation, extended travel, appointments, social activities, shopping and other needs. Additionally, we work with families providing quality palliative care. ■

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
