Foster care support to Child Welfare and community agency foster parents experiencing difficulties with one or more of their foster children.

This is a preventive service, aimed at averting re-placement of a child or adolescent, with benefits to the entire family.

The service allows parents to leave home for a few hours to attend events, such as school meetings, support groups, and recreational activities.
